

PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME – GREETINGS:

WHEREAS: Earthquake Awareness Week creates an important opportunity for every resident of Arkansas to prepare their homes, businesses and communities for earthquakes

WHEREAS: Investing in our own preparedness and that of our families, businesses and hometowns, can reduce fatalities and economic devastation in our communities and in our nation; and

WHEREAS: The Arkansas Department of Emergency Management, along with the Central United States Earthquake Consortium and other federal, state, local, tribal, territorial, private and volunteer agencies are working to increase public activities in preparing for earthquakes and to educate individuals on how to take action; and

WHEREAS: Emergency preparedness is the responsibility of every Arkansas citizen, and all Arkansans are urged to make preparedness a priority and work together to ensure that individuals, families and communities are prepared for disasters and emergencies of every type, including earthquakes; and

WHEREAS: All citizens of Arkansas are encouraged to participate in Earthquake Awareness Week activities and are asked to visit the website of the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management at www.adem.arkansas.gov to become more prepared;
