PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME – GREETINGS:

WHEREAS: Purchasing, contracting, and material management professionals play a significant role in the efficiency and effectiveness of government and business; and

WHEREAS: These professionals, through their combined purchasing power, spend billions of dollars each year and have a significant influence upon economic conditions throughout the world; and

WHEREAS: The Arkansas Chapter of the National Institute of Governmental Purchasing establishes cooperative relationships among its members for the development of efficient purchasing methods and practices to encourage maintenance of ethical standards, to promote uniform public procurement laws, and to promote ongoing training and certification for those engaged in the profession; and

WHEREAS: By obtaining the goods and services needed to get the job done in an efficient and economical manner, these professionals make it possible for the government to ably serve the citizens of Arkansas; and
